

Causey Arch and Beamish Woods - Commencing from the café at Causey Picnic Area, NE16 5EJ, the 5-mile (with 655ft of ascent) **YELLOW** walk takes you through a series of attractive woodlands, including the wooded gorge of Causey Burn, and there are many fine views over the surrounding countryside. The chief focal point and major historic site is the Causey Arch, one of the earliest engineering triumphs of the Industrial Revolution, which at almost 200 years is said to be the oldest-surviving railway bridge in the world. The route also passes by the North of England Open Air Museum at Beamish.
