Wolsingham and the Weardale Way - Wolsingham is an enticing little town set in an exceptionally pretty area of countryside in the middle of the Wear Valley with both charming buildings and a heritage railway to explore. A short climb at the start of this 7½-mile BLACK walk (with 785ft of ascent) is rewarded with far-reaching views across the heather-burnished hills and an airy walk beside an archetypical Pennine grouse moor, whilst the river's tussles with the limestone, offers a relaxing finale of riverside walking on the Weardale Way. Meet at the lay-by on the Hamsterley Road at Wear Bank, south of Wolsinghsam Bridge opposite the driveway to Ashes House.
